(BROADLANDS DRIVE, SLYNE ROAD, SLYNE, LANCASTER CITY) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council intend to make an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over the following lengths of roads;
  - I. Broadlands Drive, Slyne from a point outside property No.3 on Broadlands Drive, to its junction with A6 Slyne Road.
  - II. Slyne Road, from its junction with A6 Slyne Road to its junction with Main Road.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 30<sup>th</sup> June 2025 until 1700 hours on Sunday 27<sup>th</sup> July 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-
  - I. Broadlands Drive A6 Slyne Road and vice versa.
  - II. Slyne Road A6 Slyne Road and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow gas main replacement works to be carried out on behalf of Cadent Gas.
